The June monthly meeting for the Town of Franklin was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman Wesely following the Pledge of Allegiance.

Zoning administrator Suzi Sevcik noted there were 3 building permits & 1 ROW Permit issued, and an inquiry about a zoning variation for land on Cty AB. Also, there will be a public hearing on July 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 for a Rezone request from the Copper Top.

First Responder Suzi Sevcik reported that there were four calls last month & the group is recertifying in CPR this month.

Bolt Rd – Cty Q to Collegiate 10,550' x 22' Apply a single hot oil seal coat using 1/8 black granite \$51,319.00

Supervisor Duckart made a motion to approve the Bolt Rd Seal Coat, Supervisor Kleiman seconded the motion, motion carried.

 Collegiate Rd – Cty BB to Bolt 1940' x 22' Apply a double hot oil seal coat using 3/8 black granite stone on top and bottom \$27,361.00

Supervisor Duckart made a motion to approve the Collegiate Rd Double Seal Coat, Supervisor Kleiman seconded the motion, motion carried.

Final grade will be provided by Jadin.

Kewaunee Co. completed the pothole filling for a total of \$1,809.46.

The Town Board Dusty Smidle the Zoning Board of Appeals as an Alternate for a 3 year term. Motion made by Chairman Wesely, Supervisor Kleiman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Town Disbursements were discussed, approved and paid.
