December 16, 2024 MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING FOR TOWN OF FRANKLIN

The December monthly meeting for the Town of Franklin was called to order at 7:00pm by Chairman Wesely following the Pledge of Allegiance.

Officers present: Dave Wesely, Lori Kleiman, Katie Duckart, Sandy Smidle & Suzi Sevcik.

Supervisor Duckart made a motion to approve the agenda, Chairman Wesely second the motion, motion carried.

Supervisor Duckart made a motion to accept the minutes from the November Town Board meeting. Supervisor Kleiman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report, which shows a balance of \$244,672.78

Zoning administrator Suzi Sevcik noted there was one building permit issued.

First Responder Suzi Sevcik reported there were three calls this past month & the group would be providing food at the Farm Toy Show in February at the Ag Heritage Farm as a fundraiser.

Dana Boehm – Tausheks Quarry – lit the landfill material on fire, contacted the DNR & Taushek's have until 12/21/24 to remove the material.

Shawn Wendt – suggested looking at ash trees that were in the town right of way & be proactive about removing them for the next few years.

Brian Ristau Land Swap CSM – was noted that the line was angled to follow the marsh line. Supervisor Duckart made a motion to approve the CSM, Chairman Wesely second the motion, motion carried.

Short Term Rental Applications – no complaints were filed this past year; all paperwork is in order. Supervisor Duckart made a motion to approve the renewals, Supervisor Kleiman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Action Appraisals Contract Renewal – Renew for next 3 years \$11,625 per year. Supervisor Duckart made a motion to approve the renewal, Supervisor Kleiman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Projector/Screen options – After discussion, a motion was made to not exceed \$1000 by Supervisor Kleiman, Chairman Wesely second the motion, motion carried.

Update on Storm Damage Disaster Relief – our application, while approved, won't be paid by the State until their funding is replenished.

Town Disbursements were discussed, approved and paid.

Our next monthly meeting will be January 13, 2025, at the Franklin Town Hall following the Public Hearing at 6:30pm.

There being no further discussion, the Town Board meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
