

SEPTEMBER 8, 2025 MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING FOR TOWN OF FRANKLIN

The September monthly meeting for the Town of Franklin was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Wesely following the Pledge of Allegiance.

Officers present: Dave Wesely, Katie Duckart, Dusty Smidle, Sandy Smidle, & Suzi Sevcik

Chairman Wesely moved to adjust to the agenda to put the Quarry at the end. Supervisor Duckart seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Supervisor Duckart moved to accept the minutes from the August Town Board meeting. Supervisor Smidle seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report, which shows a balance of \$377,579.34.

Zoning administrator Suzi Sevcik noted there were four building permits issued for a solar array, sheds and an addition.

County Supervisor Scott Browne was not present.

EMR – There were three calls last month and they'll be looking at the grant that the Sheriff is writing to get portables.

Road Work

- Scott Construction has completed their road work
- Stop Ahead signs need to be placed yet.

Supervisor Duckart moved to approve of joining the Kewaunee Co Manure Hauling Permitting Process. Supervisor Smidle seconded the motion, motion carried.

LRIP – Supervisor Smidle attended the training and will submit for Collegiate Road for next year.

AGRIP – Supervisor Duckart had inquired with the state, and she will submit for Pribyl Rd.

Quarry update

- LKB Materials owner was present to discuss the Quarry as were Todd & Dana Boehm, Dan Novak & others. With the southern half being too deep, they will no longer dig from that side. This was agreed upon. What is in contention is that the Boehm's don't want fill brought in to bring the level up to 774' because of the possibility of contaminants in the fill.
- The town is starting the process of updating an Ordinance for Conditional Use for the Quarry's and will be discussed further at the next meeting.
- Chairman Wesely Moved to table the discussion as he will follow up with the following
 - Check with DNR on Soil Samples
 - Cost of Soil Samples going forward
 - Berms – can they be used for fill?
 - Add Well Testing to the updated Ordinance

Supervisor Duckart seconded the motion, motion carried.

Town Disbursements were discussed, approved and paid.

Our next monthly meeting will be October 13, 2025 at the Franklin Town Hall at 7:00 pm.

There being no further discussion, the Town Board meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
