ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

It is hereby resolved by the Town of Franklin, that:

WHERAS: Emergency Response to critical incidents, whether natural or manmade requires integrated professional management, and

WHEREAS: Unified Command of such incidents is recognized as the management model to maximize the public safety response, and

WHERAS: The National Incident Management Systems, herein referred to NIMS, has been identified by the Federal Government as being the requisite emergency management system for all political subdivisions, and

WHEREAS: Failure to adopt NIMS as the requisite emergency management system may preclude reimbursement to the political subdivision for costs expended during and after a declared emergency or disaster and for training and preparation for such disasters and emergencies.

THEREFORE: it shall be public policy of the Town of Franklin to adopt the NMIS concept of emergency planning and unified command. It shall further be the policy of the Town of Franklin to train public officials responsible for emergency management.
